This gender equality measure aims to support ambitious female students, already in their early career, by further expanding their scientific skills and extend mentoring.


The fund will span the time between two career steps, so the candidate can increase her productive input into the respective project.

Current situation:

- Medical students
 - After doctoral thesis no contact to workgroup or input into project
 - Scientifically interested students are "lost" in medical curriculum
- Students of natural sciences
 - Master thesis within certain time frame, this is not always in accordance with running project
 - Upcoming questions, putative publications are lost due to time issues

Objective of the fund:

- Medical students
 - To develop toward a clinical scientist
 - Continuous cooperation and Mentoring
- Students of natural sciences
 - Individually driven development/mentoring of student
 - Further progress in the project/publication

Application:

- Project proposal (application form via request on malegermcells.de)
- Evaluation by Management Board
- After the funding period, a final report has to be written.
- Submission deadline: 31.12.2019
